1. Current status of e-labeling implementation

- Increased demand(need) for for electronic information(e-labeling) of pharmaceuticals as the information accessibility environment such as mobile and electronic devices changes rapidly
- "E-labeling" was selected as one of the 100 priority tasks of the MFDS regulatory innovation in 2022
- The process of collecting opinions is carried out through the operation of a consultative group consisted of consumers, healthcare experts, pharmaceutical companies, and related stake holders
- > The Pilot project for prescription drugs from 2023 to 2024 by impact assessment



1. Current status of e-labeling implementation

Promotion of Pharmaceutical Affairs Law Amendment The National Assembly proposed an amendment to the Pharmaceutical Affairs Act('23.1.6, 1.17)

<Main contents of Pharmaceutical Affairs Act amendment>

- ♦ (Article 56) Barcodes, QR codes, etc. for electronic provision of drug information can be written on drug containers or packages
- (Article 58) Electronic information for prescription drugs



2. Pilot project of pharmaceuticals in 2023

- (target drugs) A total of 27 products, injections only used in medical institutions from 10 manufactuers(licence holders)
- (Method) Exemption from the provision of paper insert when providing electronic information(e-labeling)
- · (Provider) Link to the website of the licence holders
- (Considerations for vulnerable population) Prepare an alterative way to provide paper insert or document if medical institutions request
 - * For instance, paper attachments, photos, e-mail, faxes, etc.




